### ***Concerts in solo :***

#### **Acoustics:**

For small size theaters (up to 100 persons), I am self-sufficient with my amplifier.  
For larger theaters, my amplifier has to be « boosted » on a more powerful acoustic which will be provided and installed by the concert organizers.

The organizer will provide:

- A plug located at the level of the theatrical area.
- A theatrical area (if possible, a stage), of at least 2 x 3 m, must be enlightened.
- A chair
- A bottle of water
- A dressing room or a quiet and secure isolated place where I can store my music instruments and where I can retire for at least 60 minutes before the concert (Drinks and snacks are welcome).

A parking or an easy access to the building where will be the concert is very important, at the back stage would be the perfect solution if it is possible, as to unload the equipment without problem ! If it is impossible, I will need some help to unload and carry the equipment.

### ***Concerts in trio :***

#### **Acoustics:**

For small size theaters (up to 250 persons), we are self-sufficient with our complete acoustic system.

For larger theaters, my equipment has to be « boosted » on a more powerful acoustic which will be provided and installed by the concert organizers.

The organizer will provide:

- 4 plugs (or a multi-plug) located at the level of the theatrical area
- A theatrical area (if possible, a stage), of at least 3 x 4 m, must be enlightened.
- 3 bottles of water
- A dressing room or a quiet and secure isolated place where I can store my music instruments and where I can retire for at least 60 minutes before the concert (Drinks and snacks are welcome).
